

## **SCRIPTURE READING** 1 Timothy 6:6-19

<sup>6</sup> Of course, there is great gain in godliness combined with contentment; <sup>7</sup> for we brought nothing into the world, so that we can take nothing out of it; <sup>8</sup> but if we have food and clothing, we will be content with these. <sup>9</sup>But those who want to be rich fall into temptation and are trapped by many senseless and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction. <sup>10</sup> For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, and in their eagerness to be rich some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many pains. <sup>11</sup>But as for you, [people] of God, shun all this; pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance, gentleness. <sup>12</sup> Fight the good fight of the faith; take hold of the eternal life, to which you were called and for which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. <sup>13</sup> In the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who in his testimony before Pontius Pilate made the good confession, I charge you <sup>14</sup> to keep the commandment without spot or blame until the manifestation of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>15</sup> which he will bring about at the right time—he who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords. <sup>16</sup> It is he alone who has immortality and dwells in unapproachable light, whom no one has ever seen or can see; to him be honor and eternal dominion. Amen. <sup>17</sup> As for those who in the present age are rich, command them not to be haughty, or to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but rather on God who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. <sup>18</sup> They are to do good, to be rich in good works, generous, and ready to share, <sup>19</sup> thus storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of the life that really is life.

[Jesus said:] <sup>f9</sup> "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and who feasted sumptuously every day. <sup>20</sup> And at his gate lay a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, <sup>21</sup> who longed to satisfy his hunger with what fell from the rich man's table; even the dogs would come and lick his sores. <sup>22</sup> The poor man died and was carried away by the angels to be with Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried. <sup>23</sup> In Hades, where he was being tormented, he looked up and saw Abraham far away with Lazarus by his side. <sup>24</sup> He called out, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am in agony in these flames.' <sup>25</sup> But Abraham said, 'Child, remember that during your lifetime you received your good things, and Lazarus in like manner evil things; but now he is comforted here, and you are in agony. <sup>26</sup> Besides all this, between you and us a great chasm has been fixed, so that those who might want to pass from here to you cannot do so, and no one can cross from there to us.' <sup>27</sup> He said, 'Then, father, I beg you to send him to my father's house—<sup>28</sup> for I have five brothers—that he may warn them, so that they will not also come into this place of torment.' <sup>29</sup> Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the prophets; they should listen to them.' <sup>30</sup> He said, 'No, father Abraham; but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent.' <sup>31</sup> He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.'"

## Get Ready: Church Directory Update is Coming Soon!

It's almost time for our online church directory update to begin! The first step is ensuring your information is up to date and represents what you would like other Crown of Glory members to know about your family, such as names, addresses, email addresses, phone numbers, and a digital family photo.

#### Step 1 – Review/Update Information

To begin this process, on approximately October 15, all active members who have an email address listed with Crown of Glory will receive an email from our directory platform, Icon Systems.

- The email subject line will read: "Your IconCMO Log-in Information from Crown of Glory Lutheran Church."
- You will be given a generated Username, and a link will be provided in the email for you to create and set up your password. Please note, you cannot change your generated Username.
- Once you complete the password set up you can enter the Icon Systems Member Portal to review and update your personal data.
- The link provided in the email is only active for 48 hours for security purposes. If you aren't able to respond before the email expires, please email Sara Keim (<a href="mailto:sara@crownofglory.org">sara@crownofglory.org</a>) to ask her to resend the email.
- Only one person needs to respond per household, so please coordinate with your family members
  who will do that.

## Special notes about email addresses:

If you don't believe the church has an email address for you, please notify Sara Keim prior to October 13 (sara@crownofglory.org) to provide that information.

Once you have completed the paper form you can return it to the church office.\*\*
