LITANY OF PEACE

- P: O God our Creator, we are your people in a world that is thirsty for your peace.
- C: You offer reconciliation and lasting hope to all who cry out to you.
- P: O God our provider, amid the brokenness and the uncertainties of this world, our cup is nearly empty.
- C: You call us your children, together as one community of faith. Claimed and unclaimed, accepted and rejected, together and alone, we cry out to you for your peace.
- P: O God our redeemer, you shelter us in our time of need, you cover us in your light, and you deliver us with your love.
- C: Come near to us now, O God. May your spirit be alive in our song. May your presence be known at our table. May this world be filled with your peace.
- P: As we gather here today, we give thanks for this great reminder of peace. This Peace Pole was installed and dedicated in 2018 by our very first "Peace Team". There are 8 known languages on this pole, with same exact phrase in each language. The pole reads: "May Peace Prevail on Earth". Today we re-dedicate this pole, as we do every year, as a symbol of our hope and one powerful expression of peace. Today, September 21, is the International Day of Peace, where people from all over the world offer one minute of silence, thinking, praying and living out the peace that God wants for us all.

I am not strong enough to dig, and I am ashamed to beg. 4 I have decided what to do so that, when I am dismissed as manager, people may welcome me into their homes.' 5 So, summoning his master's debtors one by one, he asked the first, 'How much do you owe my master?' ⁶ He answered, 'A hundred jugs of olive oil.' He said to him, 'Take your bill, sit down quickly, and make it fifty.' ⁷ Then he asked another, 'And how much do you owe?' He replied, 'A hundred containers of wheat.' He said to him, 'Take your bill and make it eighty.' 8 And his master commended the dishonest manager because he had acted shrewdly; for the children of this age are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light. ⁹ And I tell you, make friends for yourselves by means of dishonest wealth so that when it is gone, they may welcome you into the eternal homes. 10 "Whoever is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much; and whoever is dishonest in a very little is dishonest also in much. ¹¹ If then you have not been faithful with the dishonest wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches? ¹² And if you have not been faithful with what belongs to another, who will give you what is your own? ¹³ No slave can serve two masters; for a slave will either hate the one and love the other, or be devoted to the one and despise the other. 
